Mae Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru, sef yr awdurdod traffig ar gyfer Cefnffordd yr A40 o Lundain i Abergwaun (y cyfeirir ati yma wedi hyn fel "y gefnffordd"), drwy arfer y pwerau a drosglwyddwyd iddo gan adran 84(1) a (2) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984(1) a phob pŵer galluogi arall, ac ar ôl ymgynghori â Phrif Swyddog yr Heddlu ar gyfer Heddlu Dyfed-Powys, yn gwneud drwy hyn y Gorchymyn canlynol (2) :

The National Assembly for Wales, as traffic authority for the A40 London to Fishguard Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Police, hereby makes the following Order(2) :

1. Daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 10 Gorffennaf 2006 a'i enw yw Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A40 (Withybush, Hwlfordd, Sir Benfro) (Terfynau Cyflymder 40 mya a 50 mya) 2006.

1. This Order comes into force on 10 July 2006. The title to this order is the A40 Trunk Road (Withybush, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire) (40 mph and 50 mph Speed Limits) Order 2006.

2. Ni chaiff neb yrru, na pheri na chaniatáu i unrhyw gerbyd fynd ar gyflymder sy'n fwy na 40 milltir yr awr ar y darn hwnnw o'r gefnffordd yn Withybush Hwlfordd yn Sir Benfro a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 1 i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

2. No person may drive, or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in those lengths of the trunk road at Withybush Haverfordwest in the County of Pembrokeshire described in Schedule 1 to this Order.

3. Ni chaiff neb yrru, na pheri na chaniatáu i unrhyw gerbyd fynd ar gyflymder sy'n fwy na 50 milltir yr awr ar y darn hwnnw o'r gefnffordd yn Withybush Hwlfordd yn Sir Benfro a ddisgrifir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

3. No person may drive, or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in that length of the trunk road at Withybush Haverfordwest in the County of Pembrokeshire described in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Lengths of the A40 Trunk Road at Wthybush,
Haverfordwest in the County of Pembrokeshire.

SCHEDULE 1

- i. That length of trunk road which extends
from a point 218 metres south of its junction
with Wthybush Road Roundabout to a point
at its junction with Wthybush Road
Roundabout.
- ii. That length of trunk road which extends
from a point at its junction with Wthybush
Road Roundabout to a point 103 metres
north of its junction with Wthybush Road
Roundabout.
- iii. That length of trunk road which extends
from a point at its junction with Wthybush
Road Roundabout to a point 116 metres
south east of its junction with Wthybush
Road Roundabout.
- iv. That length of trunk road which extends the
complete circulatory carriageway of the
Wthybush Road Roundabout.

SCHEDULE 2

- i. That length of trunk road which extends
from a point 103 metres north of its junction
with Wthybush Road Roundabout to a point
646 metres north of its junction with
Wthybush Road Roundabout.

THE A40 TRUNK ROAD (HAVERFORDWEST BYPASS, DYFED)
(DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 1994

MADE	27 th JUNE	1994
COMING INTO FORCE	8 th JULY	1994

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Police hereby orders and directs as follows:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 8th JULY 1994 and may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (Haverfordwest Bypass, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1994 .
2. In this Order "the trunk road" means the London - Fishguard Trunk Road (A40).
3. Those lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Act of 1984.

SCHEDULE

Those lengths of the trunk road at Haverfordwest in the County of Dyfed comprising:-

- i. that length of the trunk road, forming part of the Haverfordwest eastern Bypass, which extends from a point 13 metres south of the centrepoint of, and including, Narberth Road Roundabout for a distance of 220 metres in a north-easterly direction; *to the new scotchwell RA?*
- ii. that length of the trunk road, forming part of the Haverfordwest eastern Bypass, which extends from a point 190 metres south of the centre-point of, and including, Cardigan Road Roundabout to Fishguard Road Roundabout; *to the new roundabout RA?*
- iii. that length of the trunk road known as Fishguard Road which extends from a point 50 metres south of the centre-point of, and including, Fishguard Road Roundabout in a northerly direction for a distance of 185 metres.
