You must be a British, Commonwealth Citizen or Citizen of the Republic of Ireland; and be 18 years of age or over and meet at least one of the following criteria*:

- registered as a local government elector for the community named above; or
- during the whole of the last 12 months preceding the appointment occupied as owner or tenant, land or other premises in the community named above; or
- your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the community named above; or
- you have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the community or within 4.8 kilometres of it;
- and is not disqualified from holding office by reason of disqualification set out in section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972, or any decision made under section 79 of the Local Government Act 2000

Interested parties are invited to write to the undersigned within **FOURTEEN** days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays) of the date of this Notice, outlining why they wish to be considered for co-option with a copy of their CV.
