- You have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the community of within 4.8 kilometres of it

Interested parties are invited to write to the undersigned within **FOURTEEN** days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays) of the date of this Notice, outlining why they wish to be considered for co-option with a copy of their CV.
