

**LOCAL DEMOCRACY AND BOUNDARY COMMISSION FOR WALES  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DEMOCRACY) (WALES) ACT 2013  
REVIEW OF ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE  
COUNTY OF PEMBROKESHIRE**

On 11 July 2019 the Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales have submitted to the Welsh Government a report containing their Final Proposals in respect of the review of the electoral arrangements for the County of Pembrokeshire.

On receipt of the report, the Welsh Government may, if it thinks fit, make an order giving effect to any proposals made to it by the Commission either as submitted or with modifications. Any order giving effect to such proposals shall not be made until after the expiry of six weeks from the day on which proposals were submitted to the Welsh Government.

The report has been published and copies together with a map are on deposit at the offices of Pembrokeshire County Council and at the offices of the Commission and will be available for inspection until the expiration of six months after the making of any order giving effect to the proposals, or after notification by the Welsh Government that it does not propose to give effect to the proposals.

Arrangements are being made to place copies of the report in each public library in the County of Pembrokeshire and a limited number will be available on request from the Secretary of the Commission at Hastings House, Fitzalan Court, Cardiff, CF24 0BL.

Mae'r adroddiad wedi ei gyhoeddi a bydd copïau ohono a map yn swyddfeydd Cyngor Sir Benfro ac yn swyddfeydd y Comisiwn a byddant ar gael i'w harchwilio am hyd at chwe mis ar ôl i unrhyw orchymyn i weithredu'r cynigion gael ei wneud, neu ar ôl i Llywodraeth Cymru hysbysu nad yw'n bwriadu gweithredu'r cynigion.

Mae trefniadau hefyd yn mynd rhagddynt i osod copïau o'r adroddiad ymhob llyfrgell gyhoeddus yn Sir Benfro a bydd nifer cyfyngedig ar gael drwy wneud cais amdanynt, gan Ysgrifennydd y Comisiwn yn Ty Hastings, Llys Fitzalan, Caerdydd, CF24 0BL.
