

**Pembrokeshire County Council
Community Delivery Project
Environmental Services**

The Community Delivery project was approved by the Council's Cabinet on 2nd July 2018 (the report can be found by clicking [HERE](#)). The project is seeking community support for various non-statutory services which otherwise might be at risk of being withdrawn, including:

- Public toilets
- Playparks
- Parks, gardens & public open spaces

Community delivery isn't new, there are already examples of communities taking on responsibility for public toilets, community groups running their own playparks, and communities determining how to best manage their open green spaces.

The County Council is open to discussing innovative ways to deliver these services, so that they are sustainable in the long term. The main options are:

- County Council continues to maintain asset, with T&CC meeting the cost
- Maintenance responsibility is transferred to T&CC under a lease agreement
- A full 'asset transfer' to the T&CC takes place

Where the T&CC does not wish to take on the responsibility, the County Council is very likely to either place the asset into 'minimal maintenance' or declare it surplus to requirements where practical to do so.

Over the coming months we will be approaching Town & Community Councils to discuss assets in their areas, with the aim that where communities wish to take over responsibility for one or more assets in their area, this can be factored in to the precept setting process for financial year 2020-21.
